- S. 920 "Federal Maritime Commission Authorization Act of 1999."
- S. Res 32 Resolution expressing sense of Senate reaffirming Cargo Preference Policy of U.S.
- S. 1059 "Defense Authorization Bill fiscal year 2000."
- H.R. 2084 "Department of Transportation and Related Agencies Appropriations Act. 2000."
- H.R. 1557 "Maritime Administration Authorization Act for fiscal years 2000 and 2001."
- H.R. 1260 "Water Resources Development Act of 1999."

(Ship Act) repeals harbor maintenance tax and authorizes general revenues to pay federal costs of Harbor Programs.

H.R. 975 · "Steel Import Limitation Bill."

Provides for reduction in volume of steel imports and to establish a steel import notification and monitoring program.

H.R. 820 - "Coast Guard Authorization Act of 1999."

Authorize Coast Guard appropriations fiscal years 2000 and 2001.

H.R. 316 - "Cruises to Nowhere Act."

Restores effectiveness of State laws over gambling cruises to nowhere.

H.R. 265 - "Shipping Income Reform Act."

Allows U.S. owners of non-U.S.-flag ships to defer taxes on profits that were reinvested in the business.

H.R. 248 - "U.S. Cruise Tourism Act."

Permits certain foreign-flag cruise ships to operate between U.S. Ports.

S. 1510 - The United States Cruise Vessel Act.

H.R. 3138 - "Free Market Antitrust Reform Act of 1999."
