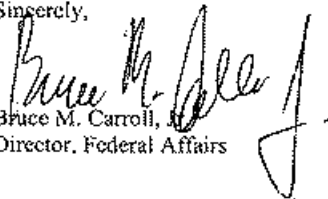
Attached please find a copy of my signed termination report as referenced above.
