Dear Mr. Pringeton:

As we discussed today by telephone, I received the Lobbying Disclosure Electronic Filing System CD ("CD") and after downloading the CD, I tried to secure an electronic signature from IdentTrust/DST ACES. Unfortunately, I was unable to complete the process due to the possible virus contamination of their website. Please note this is my second attempt to secure an electronic digital signature, this first attempt was in January, 2006.

When I attempted to use the CD and contacted the IdentTrust/DST ACES website this time, a notice from Mozilla Firefox.Exe appeared and read as follows: "Firefox.Exe has encountered a problem and needs to close". Immediately after the Firefox notification, my Symantec Antivirus notified me that a virus, "W32Beagle.M @mm" was detected. The date and time of the attempted infections were exactly the same date and times as my numerous attempts to contact IdentTrust/DST ACES. As a result, I concluded that the website may be contaminated and therefore, I was unable to obtain a digital signature to complete my filings, and I cannot file the year end and client termination report online.

Therefore, as you instructed, I will file my last report with the House and Senate by means of this letter and I would also like to terminate the only client, Goldsmith Plants, Inc. (Senate ID # 74410-36 and House ID # 36023001) as January 8, 2007.

From July 1, 2006 to December 31, 2006, Goldsmith Plants, Inc. paid the registrant, Edwin K. Marzec, A Law Corp, a total of \$60000.00 (rounded to the nearest \$20,000.00). I received no other monies from any other parties for Federal lobbying.

I am filing this letter report with the U.S. Senate by sending a copy of this letter to The U.S. Senate, Office of Public Records, Hart Senate Office Building, Suite 232, Washington, DC.

I am sorry for any inconvenience this may have caused and I appreciate your help and cooperation.
