January - June 2000

- Funding for feasibility study for Lower Fox River project. Applicable bills are the House (H.R. 4733) and Senate Energy and Water Appropriations bills. There is no current number for the Senate bill.
- Issues related to energy deregulation contained in H.R. 2944 and S2098.
- Tax issues unrelated to any particular bill. The issues include international tax reform (allocation of interest expense), bioenergy and biomass incentives, and tax incentives for growing timber.
- Support for PNTR (H.R. 4444)
- Changes to Corps of Engineers Policy Guidance Letter Number 49 including Water Resources and Development Act legislation (S2796). There is currently no House bill number.
- Changes to Natural Resource Damages of Superfund. Contacts were related to any potential Superfund measure that might move forward in this session.
- Contact with members of Congress on effort by EPA to regulate non-hazardous boiler ash as a hazardous waste under RCRA.
- Employee liability provisions of Patients Rights (Managed Care) legislation - H.R. 2723.
- Hours of Service Rules proposed by the Transportation Department. Related to S2720, Senate Transportation Appropriations bill.
