S.424, Earthquake Loss Reduction Act of 2001 - encourages earthquake mitigation by providing a specified credit against federal income taxes, allowing business to depreciate the cost of seismic retrofit over 5 years and authorizing a \$1 billion Reduction Trust Fund.
