


Failure to file a 2000 Midyear Amended Report to correct the following error or omission for American Council of Korean Travel Agents ID #33768001:

- **Line 16 was omitted. Line 16 requires the disclosure of specific lobbying issue including bill numbers and specific executive branch actions.**

You are required by law to provide an appropriate response within **60 days** of the date of this letter [2 U.S.C. §1605(8)]. Failure to do so will result in referral of this matter to the **United States Attorney for the District of Columbia** for legal action. Please be advised that violators of the Lobbying Disclosure Act are subject to a **civil fine** of up to \$50,000.
