Dear Sir or Madam:

Today I received a letter from the U.S. Senate dated February 2, 2004, addressed to my former business address (attached). The letter relates to a supposed failure by my former law firm, Wiley Rein & Fielding LLP at 1776 K Street, NW, to make a lobbying termination filing for mid-year 2003. For your information, I left WRF in October 2002 to become general counsel of Coors Brewing Company in Golden, Colorado. Since then I have performed no work for Hershey Foods Corporation. I represented Hershey while at WRF. I do not know why there was a two month delay in my receiving the February letter. That letter refers to a December 3, 2003 letter which I never received.

I have contacted Amy Haywood at WRF, who handles lobbying filings for the firm. Ms. Haywood informs me that WRF in fact made a termination filing at year-end in 2002 for Hershey Food Corporation (attached). I think that should be conclusive, but if not, just let me know. In any event, please correspond with me at my correct address as set forth in this letter.
