H.R.3287 – A bill to re-designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 5 Brentwood Road, NE, in Washington, DC as the “Joseph Curseen, Jr. and Thomas Morris, . Processing and Distribution Center”.

H.R. 5702 – A bill to provide for the privatization of the United States Postal Service.

H.R. 2754 – A bill to establish a Presidential Commission on the United States Postal Servi

S1022 & HR2125 – Both bills would allow postal, federal and military retirees to pay their health insurance premiums with pre-tax dollars.
