

MPRI, Inc. is a wholly owned subsidiary of L-3 Communications Corporation. I am writing you on behalf of both L-3 Communications and MRPI.

MPRI received a notice from the U.S. Senate, Office of the Secretary, Office of Public Records that MPRI had failed to file the 2006 Midyear LD-2 Report. Upon review of the matter noted that effective December 31, 2005, L-3 Communications, Inc. modified how it filed all L Reports. Effective January 1, 2006, all lobbying expenses for MPRI were included in the L Report filed by L-3 Communications, negating the requirement for MPRI to file the report separately. Unfortunately, the MPRI LD-2 Report for the Year End 2005 failed to include this change. Accordingly, I have enclosed an amended MPRI LD-2 Report to correct the oversight. The amended Report terminates reporting for MPRI effective December 31, 2005.
