ATTACHMENT

19. Interest of each foreign entity in the specific issues listed on line 16 above:

Insurance/Trade Issues. The interest of Lloyd's of London is similar to that of other large commercial lines insurers and reinsurers. Federal regulation of insurance (including implementation of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act) is of interest because of the effects it may have upon regulatory compliance throughout the United States. Similarly, as an organization located in a WTO member country, implementation of the WTO financial services agreement may effect its trading position in the United States and elsewhere.

Securities Law/Export Issues. The Lloyd's market was potentially effected by certain changes to U.S. securities laws proposed in the previous Congress which could be considered again. Changes in U.S. technology, export control policies potentially effect the ability of insurers outside the United States to exchange technical information related to U.S. produced equipment.
