Ozone Transport Assessment Groups (OTAG): various bills would wive the 2 percent oxygen by weight mandate for reformulated gasoline, and/or to phase out the use of MTBE (HR 1705).
National Ambient Air Quality Standards Implementation
Global Climate Change Legislation, HR 2221 would prohibit the use of federal funds to implement the Kyoto Protocol until it is ratified by the Senate, and would prohibit any federal agency from regulating carbon dioxide emissions. S. 547 would grant companies credit for early reduction of carbon emissions.
