H.R. 1295: "The Responsible Lending Act - Mortgage Lending Improvements and Uniform National Standards of 2005" - A bill to protect consumers against unfair and deceptive practices in connection with higher cost mortgage transactions.

H.R. 4320: "Flood Insurance Reform and Modernization Act of 2005" - A bill to protect consumers against unf and deceptive practices in connection with higher cost mortgage transactions.

H.R. 3505: "Financial Services Regulatory Relief Act of 2005" - A bill to provide regulatory relief to financial institutions.

H.R. 3909: "Hurricane Check Cashing Relief Act of 2005" - A bill to provide emergency authority for the Fede Deposit Insurance Corporation and the National Credit Union Administration, in accordance with guidance iss by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, to guarantee checks cashed by insured depositor institutions and insured credit unions for the benefit of non-customers who are victims of certain 2005 hurrical and for other purposes.

H.R. 4133: "National Flood Insurance Program Further Enhanced Borrowing Authority of 2005" - To temporal increase the borrowing authority of the Federal Emergency Management Agency for carrying out the national flood insurance program.

H.R. 4146: "Hurricanes Rita and Wilma Financial Services Relief Act of 2005" - A bill to facilitate recovery fror effects of Hurricane Rita and Hurricane Wilma by providing greater flexibility for, and temporary waivers of ce requirements and fees imposed on, depository institutions, credit unions, and Federal regulatory agencies, ar other purposes.

H.R. 4100: "The Louisiana Recovery Corporation Act" - A bill to establish the Louisiana Recovery Corporation an independent establishment in the executive branch whose primary mission shall be the economic stabiliza and redevelopment of areas within Louisiana that were devastated or significantly distressed by Hurricane Κε or Hurricane Rita.
