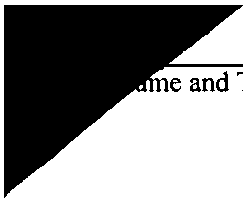

HR 3045 Central America Free Trade Agreement – Educated Members of the House and Senate on the benefits of the agreement between the U.S. and the six parties of the DR-CAFTA agreement.

S. 1932 Byrd Amendment – The Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 – Worked with Congressional Leaders to repeal the Continued Subsidy and Deficit Offset Act also known as the “Byrd Amendment”. The repeal was ultimately included in the Budget Deficit and Reduction Act of 2005.

HR 4340 Free Trade Agreement between the US and Bahrain – Participated in coalition meetings with House and Senate staff on the importance of advancing the U.S. trade agenda – although a small market, Bahrain FTA is an important precedent for the future of trade policy in the U.S.

HR 3283 Trade Rights Enforcement Act – Educated House staff about the repercussions this legislation would have on the U.S. economy and further stress the U.S.-China relationship if enacted.

HR 683 Trademark Dilution Revision Act – Worked with a coalition of companies to define some of the legislative language regarding “trade dress”.

S 295 Schumer-Graham re: Chinese Currency – Communicated with Senators and staff on the negative impact this legislation would have on the U.S. economy if enacted.

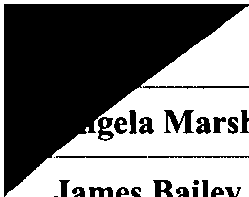
