16. Specific lobbying issues **Energy Taxes--** The energy tax titles of both energy bills, HR 6 by Rep. Barton (R-TX) Domenici (R-NM), were added to the energy bills, both of which passed in their respective House title, approved by Ways and Means first, included a provision to reduce depreciation electric transmission assets from 20 to 15 years on a permanent basis. The Senate title Finance, included a one-year extension of the Transco provision enacted in last year's 4520 by Rep. Thomas, R-CA) and applies to sales or disposition of transmission facilities to 1/1/08.

**Pension Changes--** Talked to Treasury to clarify tax treatment of pensions for UK workers U.S. temporarily. Also submitted possible language to Senate Finance and House Ways inclusion in a forthcoming technical corrections bill to cover items which are not covered by regulations later this year.
