S. 2338/ H.R. 4066 - ENFORCE. Support legislation to enhance the resources available to federal agencies charged with enforcement of the gun laws and to make changes to existing law to enhance effectiveness of those laws. S. 2525 - Legislation to require the licensing of gun owners and registration of handguns and specific other firearms. S. 353 - Oppose legislation to make it harder to bring class action lawsuits. Support amendment to exempt firearm manufacturers from bill's protection. H.R. 2366 - Oppose legislation to make it more difficult to bring civil lawsuits against "small businesses."
