
Dear Sir or Madam:

On February 28, 2006, Swidler Berlin LLP (registrant # 37460) merged with Bingham McCutchen LLP (registrant # 51560). Based on the advice of the Office of Public Records, and on our understanding of the requirements under the rule at the time, Swidler Berlin LLP's past practice with respect to lobbying reports was to update the registrant name on the next required lobbying report filing subsequent to the date of the merger. After consulting with the Office of Public Records, we have been advised that because Bingham McCutchen LLP is an existing registrant, Bingham McCutchen LLP will need to file lobbying registrations for the Swidler Berlin LLP clients for which lobbying work is still performed. Additionally, we have been advised that Swidler Berlin LLP will need to file termination lobbying reports with the next filing deadline.

The purpose of this letter is to assure the Office of Public Records of our continuing intent to comply with all filing obligations and deadlines and to explain why the Bingham McCutchen LLP lobbying registrations for Swidler Berlin LLP clients will reflect a March 1, 2006 effective date of registration.
