Congressional Contacts:

- HR2506 Foreign Operations Appropriations Act – Attended various meetings to develop strategy to further enactment of this legislation.
- HR2517 Reauthorization of the Export-Import Bank of the U.S. - Pending in both the House and Senate. Met with Hill staff and co-signed letters urging passage. Voiced opposition to inclusion of amendments that would impact negatively on the ability of the Bank to provide competitive financing.
- S1510 US Patriot Act of 2001 – Worked with other associations to refine language of Title III to the Act.
- HR 2052 Sudan Peace Act – Met with Congressional staffers in an effort to have Sections 8 and 9 of the proposed Act eliminated or changed significantly.
- Cosigned trade association letter to Congress urging amendment of Subpart F of the Internal Revenue Code.
