Dear Senate Office of Public Records:


I have had an exceedingly difficult time trying to file a lobbying form electronically. I have been trying to do so for three weeks now, and every time I try to advance in this process I encounter a new red tape problem. I had trouble entering the website for the Digital Signature Trust to obtain my ACES certificate, apparently because I do not have the kind of new and more expensive equipment that large firms have. I am an individual lobbyist working on anti-poverty issues in the Mississippi Delta region, and I have older and limited equipment. I am eager to fulfill all requirements in the forms.

I received notice from Digital Signature Trust that my application had been approved, but this did not help me because I could not get through the computerized process, at first, and when I finally went to and rented a different computer to get through that hurdle, the pass phrase I had entered was repeatedly rejected. I wrote the pass phrase down originally, but apparently must have included a typographical error and so I could not get through that obstacle. Apparently the same thing happened with the three "secret questions" that are supposed to remedy the problem if you have forgotten your pass phrase. I have previously filed in hard copy, and have found the process extremely frustrating, cumbersome and excessively bureaucratic.

I would like to thank Mr. Steve Pingeton of the House Legislative Resource Center for informing me that for this filing, I can submit the forms in hard copy, and they are enclosed.

With the additional time that I have now, I will make renewed efforts to use this system. If you can make this system easier, this would be appreciated. A different method of keeping the process secure, by a simpler pass phrase system, would be helpful.
