I spoke to the clerk in the Senate Office of Public Records. I explained the problem of running LD2's as LD1's. That the sopr.senate.gov screen won't display anything to the public screens, payroll won't get there displays to activate procedures, I would assume since both runs must run equally L.R.C. and S.O.P.R. This might also interfere with the employee packet being sent automatically if they run everybody's reports as lobbyist no matter the title. I had to call for my employee packet and got excellent orientation. As my copies of my employee packet show, you must after the LD2 road map qualifier complete the forms with the new title, Congress person, you are not told to fill it in you have to know by your Federal identifier - code 5 section 2105. Lobbyist are not paid and not recognized. They are in limbo until they qualify by the LD2 road map. The expense account is given only after the LD2's run as LD2's in both departments, L.R.C. & S.O.P.R. Therefore If LD2's are not run as LD2's the computer won't recognize any run. When it gets the right run it will dump into the "Registrants' screen". Mid-year and year-end runs

do not recognize or register LD1's or Lobbieist.

I mentioned to her Senator Arlen Specter should be in to assist to make sure the LD2's run as LD2's.

I will send the other two departments' letters in with the mid-year reports after the 3rd of August.
