



H.R. 6, "Energy Policy Act of 2004," Energy Tax Title tax, relief for selling transmission assets to an independent transmission entity (Transco), accelerated depreciation for transmission upgrades and electric transmission investment S. 1637, H.R. 1769, H.Res 534 and H.R. 4520: issues relating to changes in the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, Section 163(j) within the foreign sales corporation extraterritorial income tax reform bills and Transco tax relief.
H.R. 3108, "Pension Funding Equity Act of 2004," signed into law, the legislation was aimed at enhancing protection for pension plan assets. The final act replaced for two years the 30 year Treasury bond rate with a corporate bond rate. Over the next two years, Congress will reevaluate the pension system and try to agree on a permanent solution.






