EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Berkeley County, West Virginia was added to the Washington, DC MSA (along with neighboring Jefferson County) as a result of the 1990 census. The 2000 census delineations were finalized by OMB on June 6, 2003 and exclude Berkeley County, West Virginia from the Washington, DC Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA). Berkeley County was combined with the existing Hagerstown, MD MSA (Washington County, MD) to form the three-county Hagerstown-Martinsburg MSA that also includes Morgan County, West Virginia.

HHS's Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) plans to publish proposed inpatient rule for FFY 2005 in early May 2004. They will announce how, and when the new census designations will be used to define labor market areas for future years.

If City Hospital in Martinsburg (Provider Number 51-0008) receives a wage index based on the newly expanded Hagerstown-Martinsburg MSA, the hospital will lose \$2,409,000 per year in Medicare payment.

City Hospital seeks congressional assistance in maintaining the Washington, DC wage index to keep operations stable at the current level.
