

Dear Secretary of the Senate:

Enclosed are amended lobbying reports for the period January-June, 2005. I originally submitted reports relating to our clients with the box for item 11 unchecked – thereby indicating that lobbying activity had occurred – while the box for numl 17 was checked – thereby indicating we had no lobbying contacts for the period. We took this approach because members of the firm had engaged in “lobby activities”, such as the preparation of background documents for our clients to use in making lobbying contacts, but no one from the firm had made a lobbying contact.

However, following up on a notice of an erroneous filing, we were told by someone working either in your office or the office of the Clerk of the House that we should submit amended reports, checking item 11, “No Lobbying Activity,” and provide only page one of the report. Apparently this advice was based on the notion that without a lobbying contact, there could be no lobbying activity. We did as instructed. However, we have since learned that this advice was incorrect and that the reports we originally filed were completed correctly. Hence, we are now submitting amended reports that reflect our original approach. These reports are submitted in paper format because they relate to a period for which this format was permitted.
