

<u>Insurance/Trade Issues</u>. The interest of Lloyd's of London is similar to that of other large commercial lines insurers and reinsurers. Federal regulation of insurance (include implementation of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act) is of interest because of the effects it may have upon regulatory complaints throughout the United States. Similarly, as an organization located in a WTO member country, implementation of the WTO financial services agreement may effect its trading position in the United States and elsewhere.

Bankruptcy Law. The Lloyd's Market would be effected by a provision in one version of the bankruptcy bill currently being considered by Congress. This provision would effectively bar enforcement of certain foreign judgments in U.S. Courts.

Export Issues. Changes in U.S. technology, export control policies potentially effect ability of insurers outside the United States to exchange technical information related 1 U.S. produced equipment.

<u>Tax</u>. Like other foreign reinsurers with U.S. activities, Lloyd's Underwriters potential could face compliance burdens in establishing exemption from the related-party reinsurance tax provisions of H.R. 1755.
