In accordance with the above referenced letter, we have reviewed the information provided in the 2004 Mid-year Report and have determined that the expenses inadvertently under-reported. We appreciate your letter bringing this to attention.

We have carefully reviewed our present and past reporting procedures. We determined our status this past six months narrowly exceeded the twenty percent threshold with one of our associates. We know the current six month cycle was less than the twenty percent threshold. As a result, we may take the appropriate steps to terminate our registration.
