
Dear Ms. Galvin,

This letter is in response to your April 13, 2005, and January 24, 2005, letter seeking clarification on the mid-year 2004 lobbying report filed for Point Loma Industries (17226-315).

For the record, Haake & Associates concluded its lobbying activity for Point Loma Industries on July 31, 2004. **The 2004 mid-year report filed by Haake & Associates for Point Loma, which included lobbying income and lobbying issue activity, covered the entire period from 1/01/04 through 7/31/04.**

To ensure that the record accurately reflects our activity for Point Loma, attached is an amended 2004 mid-year report that simply indicates that this was not a "termination report" since the firm represented Point Loma for one additional month beyond the covered period. Moreover, Haake & Associates filed a termination report for Point Loma for the 2004 year-end report. This report was sent to you on February 14, 2005. We are including a copy of that report with this letter.
