- 4) Revamping of the flight service station (FSS) system.

- 6) FAA policy changes to reduce delays in issuing special issuance medical certification.

- 9) Discussions with FAA regarding the use of a driver's license as a medical certificate provided those pilots limit themselves to recreational pilot privileges
- 10) FAA's plan to start turning off VORs in 2007.
- 11) Privatization of air traffic control services.
- 12) The use of datalink technology in general aviation.
- 13) Michigan's law requiring pilot background checks.
- 14) Creation of the Department of Homeland Security.
