

TRD (Trade)

H.R. 4444, To authorize extension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment) to the People's Republic of China, and to establish a framework for relations between the United States and the People's Republic of China.

H. R. 4871, The Treasury Department Appropriations Bill for FY 2001. (And House Amendment 1031, prohibiting funds in the bill from being used to implement any sanction imposed by the U.S. on the private sale of medicine, food, or agricultural product to Cuba).

H. Res. 528, Withdrawing Approval of the Congress from the Agreement establishing the World Trade Organization and providing for consideration of H.J. Res. 90.

H. J. Res. 90, Withdrawing the Approval of the U.S. from the Agreement establishing the WTO.

S. 2277, A bill to terminate the application of title IV of the Trade Act of 1974 with respect to the People's Republic of China.

S. 2645, The Chinese Nonproliferation Act, to provide application of certain measures to the Peoples Republic of China in response to the illegal sale, transfer or misuse of certain controlled goods, services, or technology, and for other actions.

S. 2985, Agricultural Flexibility in Export Development and Assistance Act of 2000 - To amend the Agricultural Trade Act of 1978 to authorize the Commodity Credit Corporation to reallocate certain unobligated funds from the export enhancement program to other agricultural trade development and assistance programs.


