

1. Supported \$250,000 in funding for feasibility study for Lower Fox River project. Applicable bills are the House (H.R. 4733) and Senate Energy and Water Appropriation measures as well as the Conference Committee.
2. Opposition to Hours-of-Service Rules proposed by the Transportation Department: Related to S2720, Senate Transportation Appropriations bill.
3. Sought changes to Corps of Engineers Policy Guidance 49: Applicable bills included Senate (S2796) and House measures. Also, contacts made with the Army Corps of Engineers.
4. Sought changes to Natural Resource Damage provisions of Superfund: Contacts were related to any potential Superfund measure that might move forward. None did.
5. Opposed a specific change to recycling liability legislation enacted in 1999: Bills included House (H.R. 4635) and Senate VA\HUD appropriations measure as well as the final catch-all appropriations bill.
