Subject: June-December 2000 Semiannual Report

1. This letter forwards said referenced Subject Report.

2. This is my early years as a Lobbyist. I am still on my learning curve. My impression was that since I made less than \$10,000.00 (including reimbursables) for this effort for Singapore Technologies, there was no report due. I am now informed I must make this report and do so herewith.

3. Singapore Technologies (ST):

a. Work for ST: Assist them in their efforts to bid on and win a competitive contract with the Army for the Interim Light Armored Vehicle for selected Brigades within the Army.

b. Scope of work for ST in the reporting period:

(1) Found production facilities in the US to build their vehicles, helped them negotiate the agreement with the leadership of these production facilities, assist them in their response to the Request for Proposal (published in Mar 2000), advised them on the configuration of their vehicles and the integrated logistics in support of the program.

(a) The only production facilities that were not in the

competitors facilities which I could find were the US Army Depots. I made arrangements for ST to use these US Army Depot facilities to manufacture their Bionix armored vehicle (if they win the Army contract).

(b) I have also introduced them to OSD and Army leadership. This was necessary since the Defense Department had never heard of Singapore Technologies in the US Defense Contractor Community. (Never had a presence in the United States before in defense work.)

(c) Also I have assisted in their effort to establish a Vision Technologies - Kinetics Inc company in Huntsville, AL. We have also briefed OSD and the Army on this new company in the US Defense Contractor Community.

(c) I arranged for ST to give briefings to Defense officials on the overall company and its capabilities in defense work.

(2) I continued to familiarize appropriate Congressional Members in the Defense Committees on their company (totally unknown in US Defense circles) and their vehicles, the advantages of the vehicles in price and capabilities and, especially, the company's dedication to become a US Defense supplier with all their equipment built in the United States with US made components.

4. Gas Equipment Engineering Company (GEECo), P. O. Box 2-237 1240 Oronoque Rd., Milford CT 06480:


a. I am on the Board of this company in Connecticut. I continue to list them because they have no Washington office and I have handled any requirements they have had here in Washington generally with no charge other than the fee for my annual Board duties.

b. During the reporting period, there has been no requirement for any lobbying effort on behalf of GEECo. I still want to be able to work for them on the Hill if there is a future requirement. But I have not submitted any report because there was nothing to report.

5. GMA International Inc: I am President and CEO of GMA International Inc. If required in the future, I listed myself as a lobbyist for my own company. There has been no requirement for any lobbying on behalf of GMA.
