I assume that the User Identification Number issued me by your office for electronic transmission is my Senate Lobbying ID Number, and I have entered it above. Please correct me if I am wrong.

Enclosed is my Form LD-2 for the second half of the year 2000. Since I filed an LD-1 for the first time ever on October 17, 2000, this form covers the period from October 18, 2000 through December 31, 2000.

I now realize that this filing was due in your office on 14 February 2001. It is late solely because of my failure to completely read and understand the Lobbying Disclosure Act. I did not realize that activities in support of lobbying—such as planning, research and other background work—are considered lobbying activity. Since those were the only kinds of work I did for my client during the final ten weeks of the year 2000, I thought I was exempt from filing for the period.

I finally read the LDA Guidance on your web site and I now am fully aware of the requirement. I assure you that I will be much more attentive to my obligations under the LDA in the future. My understanding is that my next LD-2 is to be filed not later than 45 days after the end of the January 1st to June 30th period in 2001.

I apologize for the delay and appreciate your patience.
