Dear Ms. Reynolds:

Please find attached the 2003 End of Year LD-2 Forms for my twelve clients for whom I provided professional consulting and lobbying services during the period July 1- December 31, 2003.

Earlier today I spoke to a representative in the Legislative Resource Center in the office of the House Clerk and asked how to report a change in business organizational structure, i.e. changing from a single individual as a sole proprietor (where I registered with my name only) to a Limited Liability Company where I remain the sole registered lobbyist. In October 2003, I created the LLC called Capitol Resources Washington Representation, LLC and became the principal partner. No changes were made in providing consulting and lobbying services to my clients as a result of this entity change. In other words, I remain the principal lobbyist representing their interests and was already registered as such.

I was told this morning that I should submit my end of year report with the new entity's name as registrant, with the note "formerly registered as Robert M. Meissner". That way both the already assigned Senate and House ID numbers for each of my clients would still be associated by name with my previous registrations and now linked to the new entity. I have prepared all the LD-2's based on this advice and I am submitting them as required. Effective January 12, 2004 a partner has joined the LLC. On February 1, 2004 he will also begin representing all of the LLC's current clients. It is my intention to then submit the additional lobbyist's name at the next semiannual reporting date for each of the clients.

Please advise me as soon as possible if I have not properly reported the change in status from sole proprietorship to LLC on the attached LD-2's. Also, I like to know if I will need to register my new partner prior to the next semiannual report.
