

USX Corporation has changed its name to Marathon Oil Corporation, effective January 2002, after the separation of the U.S. Steel Group into an independent company. Marathon Corporation will continue to operate the business of the former Marathon Group. This business includes worldwide exploration, production, transportation, and marketing of crude oil and natural gas, as well as domestic refining, marketing, and transportation of petroleum products.
