Dual Taxation. This firm met with various congressional members and staff about seeking proposed legislation addressing the problem of dual taxation on Indian lands.

Land-into-Trust. This firm contacted various members of the Senate and House, and also provided testimony, requesting opposition to congressional preemption of ongoing efforts of the Department of the Interior to develop new regulations to guide it in determining whether to take land into trust on behalf of Indian tribes and individual Indians.

This firm contacted the Department of the Interior and various Senate and House members to discuss a water settlement for the Zuni Indian Tribe.
