S.399/H.R. 1811

A bill to provide more authority and flexibility to tribes regarding Indian gaming.

S.401

A bill to provide financial and technical assistance and administrative services to promote tribal business development.

S.550/H.R. 1814

A bill to provide for collection of state taxes from sales by tribal enterprises to non-tribal members.

S.611/H.R. 361

A bill to establish the Commission on Indian Recognition in the Department of the Interior.

S. 985

A bill to provide for negotiations between states and tribes that wish to operate gaming enterprises.

S. 692; H.R. 3125

A bill to prohibit Internet Gambling.

H.R. 103

A bill to amend the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act to protect Indian tribes from coerced labor agreements.

H.R.2572

A bill to implement certain recommendations of the National Gambling Impact Study Commission by prohibiting the placement of automated teller machines or any device by which an extension of credit or and electronic fund transfer may be initiated by a consumer in the immediate area in a gambling establishment where gambling or wagering takes place.

H.R. 2579

A bill to prevent the use of certain bank instruments for Internet gambling.
