South America

Colombia: recommendations relating to human rights, security and rule of law issues.

Eastern Europe

Serbia: recommendations regarding certification with respect to human rights issues, particularly co-operate with International Criminal Tribunal for Yugoslavia.

Caucasus: recommendations on resolving conflicts in the region.

Asia

Uzbekistan: recommendations relating to human rights issues (including Abijan and violations surrounding the cotton industry) and economic and democratic reforms.

Afghanistan: recommendations on alternative development and interdiction and law enforcement rather than small farmer eradication in the counternarcotics program and on pursuing implementation of the Human Rights Action Plan.

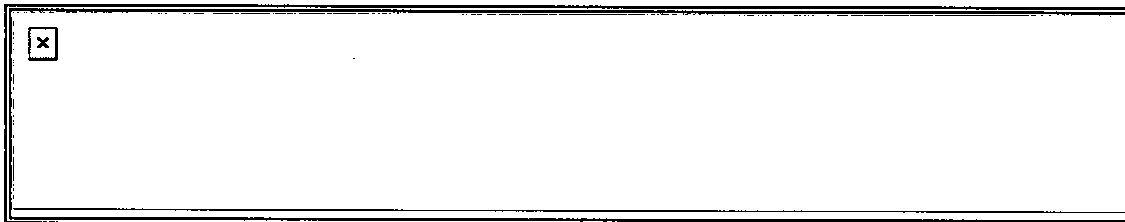
