AFSA has advocated for certain personnel related provisions of Title 3 of the House version, H.R. 2601, and the Senate version, S. 600, of the Foreign Relations Authorization Act for 2006 and 2006. These provisions include the elimination of the pay disparity between serving in Washington, D.C. and serving abroad, an increase in the caps on hardship and danger allowances, improvements on the travel portions of the Education Allowance, the restoration of "Prescriptive Relief" authority to the FSGB.


