Dear Secretary of the Senate and Clerk of the House of Representatives,

I am writing to inform you that the America Cancer Society, California Division, Inc. (ACS CA Division) recently became aware of its obligations under the federal Lobbying Disclosure Act (LDA). After participating in a lobbying event held in late September 2006, we reviewed the law and its thresholds for registration. After this review, we determined that ACS CA Division had met the threshold requirements, and may have needed to register and file reports in the past. As such, we are now registering effective April 2001 and filing reports since that date.

Because the House and Senate electronic filing systems will not accept reports prior to 2004, we are submitting our initial registration and reports through 2004 in paper form. Once our registration has become effective in the systems, we will electronically file the required reports for the covering the period from 2005 through the current reporting date.

Additionally, we would like to call to your attention that ACS CA Division has elected to use Method B of the reporting standards in order to simplify its obligations by aligning them with its reporting obligations under the United States tax code. Because this reporting method captures more than federal lobbying activity, the number disclosed in these reports is actually much greater than the amount attributable solely to ACS CA Division's federal lobbying activities. Some portion of this amount was spent on federal lobbying, but it is far less than the majority of the amounts reported.
