Worked with Congress to improve health care policy for people with chronic conditions, with primary emphasis on Medicare reform and to a lesser extent, complimentary Medicaid policy reforms. Advocated for introduction of S. 1589 and HR 3188, The Medicare Chronic Care Improvement Act of 2001. Legislation would increase coverage of preventive care, improve payment methods for specialty M+C plans focusing on frail elderly and improve fee-for-service provider payments related to frail elderly, calls for IOM study on legislative and regulatory barriers to effective chronic illness care. Also worked for support of S. 775, the Geriatric Improvement Act of 2001, to improve education of geriatricians and to provide coverage of geriatric assessment and care management services and S. 982, the Medicare Wellness Act of 2001 to improve Medicare coverage of preventive health care services.
