Dear Sir or Madam:

I am responding to your letter of November 30, 2006 to this firm regarding our failure to file a 2005 Year-End report for lobbying on behalf of the National Venture Capital Association. I am not aware of your September 1, 2006 letter. The November letter was the first notice I personally received that we have had a breakdown in lobbying reporting that began with the 2005 Year-End Report. This firm is also late in filing the 2006 midyear report, a situation I am rectifying immediately.

Enclosed are the 2005 Year-End and 2006 Midyear reports. I assure you that appropriate remedial action has been taken and new procedures are now in place to ensure that our reports will be filed on a timely basis in the future.

By way of explanation, the breakdown in our reporting coincided with efforts to move our filings from paper filings to online filings. I was informed by my administrative assistant she was changing to online filing in 2005 and I have been under the impression that the 2005 Year-End filing was accomplished by that means. Unfortunately, she was unable to complete the filings online and failed to continue tracking and completing our filings in paper. For my part, I failed to properly supervise the transition to online filing and to pay the necessary attention to these filings over the past year.

I accept full responsibility for this oversight and sincerely apologize for falling into non-compliance with the lobbying laws. As I think you can see from my prior filings, I have attempted to comply fully with the registration and reporting requirements since they became applicable to my practice. When my assistant has resolved the technical problems with the on-line filing system for form completion and authentication, amended 2005 Yearend and 2006 Midyear forms will be submitted on-line.
