Attached please find the lobbying report for July- December of 1999. Figures have been rounded.

Below is a report detailing how the total figure of \$234,470 was determined

- Akin Gump fees = \$120,000
- Consultant Fees = \$7,5002
  - Kim Sheets = \$861
  - Orion Consulting = \$2,119
  - Price Waterhouse Coopers = \$1,078
  - Mike Maher = \$3,449
- Salaries and benefits associated with federal lobbying activities for registered lobbyists = \$42,720
  - Elizabeth Vega = 20,060
  - James Quirk = \$22,660
- Administrative expenses related to federal lobbying activities = \$7,750
  - 10% of office expenses = \$4,250
  - 10% of administrative support expenses = \$3,500

Further, I estimated that approximately 70% of our activities were lobbying. Both methods estimated this figure.
