Below is a report detailing how the total figure of \$234,470 was determined

- Akin Gump fees = \$120,000¹
- Consultant Fees = \$7,500²
 - Kim Sheets = \$861
 - Orion Consulting = \$2,119
 - Price Waterhouse Coopers = \$1,078
 - Mike Maher = \$3,449
- Salaries and benefits associated with federal lobbying activities for registered lobbyists = \$42,720
