

Goodyear Orient Company (Private) Limited buys and sells natural rubber. Except for Plantaciones de Hule Goodyear, S.A., which is no longer an affiliate of The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, all of the other foreign entities listed under line 12.a. of The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company's Lobbying Registration Update, Form LD-1U, dated 8/9/96 and under line 27 of The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company's Lobbying Report dated 8/12/98 are affiliates of The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company that purchase natural rubber for use in the manufacture of rubber products.
