H.R. 4157, the Health Information Technology Promotion Act of 2005 – Support bill, with modification; promotes better records and less errors through a national electronic medical records system. ADA is concerned with adding privacy promote expanding access to health technology to individuals with lowliteracy.  H.R. 5225, The Diabetes Prevention Access and Care Act of 2006 – Support entire bill: Would expand resources at NIH at CDC to promote research, treatment, and education regarding diabetes in minority populations. We have provided ideas and assistance on crafting legislation and continue to work with the bill's sponsors to encourage passage.  S. 3917/ H.R. 6147, The Gestational Diabetes Act (GeDi Act) - Support entire bill; Legislation expands screening, diagn data collection and treatment of gestation diabetes and the children born from women with gestational diabetes.
