S. 2296, providing grants to small communities to assist with environmental projects. ECOS testified before the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee on September 26, 2000. S. 1915, to create a Small Community Advisory Committee within the Environmental Protection Agency. ECOS testified before the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee on September 26, 2000. Environmental enforcement and compliance issues -- ECOS responded to inquiries and identified witnesses for a hearing before the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee that was canceled. Corporate environmental partnerships -- ECOS surveyed States to identify good examples of corporate environmental partnerships in anticipation of a hearing before the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee. Environmental innovation -- ECOS worked with the House Government Reform Committee, Subcommittee on Regulatory Affairs, in preparation for a hearing on State innovations on September 13, 2000.
