

- Recycling, solid waste and Natural Resource Damage issues related to House and Senate Superfund legislation. This legislation included H.R. 1300, S. 1090, S. 1105 and S 2580.
- Energy deregulation legislation including S 1047 and H.R. 2050.
- Water Resources Development Act Reauthorization -- H.R. 1480, Senate bill and Conference agreement.
- Project funding request (Lower Fox River) related to House and Senate Energy and Water Appropriations measure. This included Senate bill S. 1186 and H.R. 2605 and Conference Report.
- Project funding request (Elwha Dam) related to House and Senate Interior Appropriations measures. These included Senate bill S. 1292 and House bill H.R. 2466.
- Marine Sanctuaries Reauthorization -- House bill H.R. 1243
- Activity related to EPA proposed regulations governing pretreatment standards for laundries. Also, solid waste/RCRA issues surrounding the treatment of wipers. The latter is not a formally proposed regulation at this time.
