- HR 4614: "Nursing Staff Accountability and Training Improvement Act"; To require skilled nursing facilities furnishing services to Medicare beneficiaries to submit data to HCFA with respect to nursing staff levels of the facility, to require posting of staffing information by facilities and HCFA, to assess the adequacy of training requirements for certified nurse aides, and provide for grants to improve the quality of care furnished in nursing facilities.



- HR 4040: "Long-Term Care Security Act"; To provide for the establishment of a program under which long-term care insurance is made available to Federal employees, members of Uniformed services, and civilian and military retirees.
- HR 5042: "Seniors Healing at Home Act of 2000"; To protect the right of a Medicare beneficiary enrolled in a Medicare Plus Choice plan to receive services at a skilled nursing facility where that individual lived prior to hospitalization.
- HR 4481: "To Amend Title IV and XX of the Social Security Act..."; To restore funding for the Social Services Block Grant under Title XX of the Social Security Act.


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
