H.R.1753, amends the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make the expensing of environmental remediation costs permanent law and to repeat the recapture of such expenses under Section 1254 of such code. H.R.2834, amends the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to treat income received by partners for the performing investment management services as ordinary income received for the performance of services. Legislative concept to extend and increase the commercial building tax deduction, IRS Code Section 179-D, no bill introduced at present. S.34, "The Sales Tax Fairness and Simplification Act" to promote simplification and fairness in the administration and collection of sales and use taxes. All provisions.
