Patients' Bill of Rights:

Patients deserve a comprehensive and enforceable patients' bill of rights, with a right to sue, that includes coverage for routine health care costs associated with clinical trials; access to the right providers; involvement in treatment decisions that are based on good science; confidentiality of their health information, and the right to receive accurate information about their health plans. These rights must be backed by strong enforcement mechanisms that include a private right of action in state court. NBCC urges Congress to enact H.R. 2563/S. 1052, the Bipartisan Patient Protection Act which reflects these important principles.
