

The Federal Regulation of Lobbying Act requires that we file regular financial reports on February 15<sup>th</sup> and August 15<sup>th</sup>. Clients do **not** have to file any reports on the federal level.

Please note, we must have a signed copy of your retainer before we can lobby on your behalf. If the terms of this retainer are acceptable, please sign three (3) copies; keep one for your files and return two (2) to us.


