## **LOBBYING ASSIGNMENTS – 2002**

January – June 2002

H.R. 4970 – A bill to reform the postal laws of the United States.  
S2907 – Senate bill designed to do the same thing.

H.R. 5120 – A bill making appropriations for the Treasury Department, the United States Postal Service, the Executive Office of the President, and certain Independent Agencies, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2003, and for other purposes.

S2184 - A bill designed to reduce the number of work place injuries caused by repetitive motions such as typing, lifting and assembling.

HR4954 – House Bill Medicare Modernization and Prescription Drug Act of 2002 which seeks to change the way Medicare is administered and paid for

HR664 & S661 - Bills that would remove the Government Pension Offset for anyone whose combined government pension and annuity and spousal Social Security benefit is less than \$1,000 a month.
